ORDER ABROGATING ALASKA LBR 9033-2

General Order No. 2006-2, entered on August 25, 2006, adopted amendments to the Alaska Local Bankruptcy Rules and Forms which became necessary after implementation of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (“BAPCPA”). Due to clerical oversight, General Order No. 2006-2 failed to note that AK LBR 9033-2 has been abrogated and superseded by new AK LBR 9013-3. Therefore, in accordance with the United States District Court’s Miscellaneous General Order 880, dated March 18, 2003, which grants this court the authority to adopt amendments to its Local Bankruptcy Rules,
