The Court having determined that there is an immediate need for the rules, under the authority of 28 U.S.C. § 2071(e), they are adopted effective **September 19, 2012.**

9027-1 Notice of Removal

A notice of removal must in all cases include a statement that the party does or does not consent to entry of final orders or judgments by the bankruptcy court.

Rule 9033-2 Proposed Findings and Conclusions of Law

In any proceeding in which the bankruptcy court lacks jurisdiction to enter final orders or judgments, the provisions of AK LBR 9033-1 apply.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT, unless otherwise ordered by the court, these rules shall expire and be of no further force or effect on or after **December 1, 2014**.
