- All bankruptcy paper filings and fee payments, made by check or money order, previously accepted in Fairbanks or Juneau must be sent via mail or delivery to the Anchorage office at Old Federal Building, U.S. Bankruptcy Court, 605 W. 4th Avenue, Anchorage, AK 99501. <u>Cash payments will not be accepted during this period of exigent circumstances</u>.
- 2. Staff in the Clerk's Office in Anchorage will be available by telephone at (907)271-2655, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on business days.

 This Order supersedes any inconsistent information or direction in any standing order or notice related to the Coronavirus Disease outbreak. The Court will vacate or amend this Order no later than <u>April 30, 2020.</u>
