NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE ALASKA LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES AND DEADLINE TO FILE COMMENTS THEREON

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Alaska proposes to adopt amendments to the Alaska Local Bankruptcy Rules (“LBRs”), and to amend certain Local Forms (“LBFs”). The rule amendments are intended to update the LBRs to be more consistent with local practice and with proposed revisions to the Local Rules (Civil) of the United States District Court for the District of Alaska. Also, some of the existing LBRs have been renumbered to coincide with their parallel rules in the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

All attorneys and other interested parties are encouraged to review the proposed amendments and submit comments addressing the proposed changes. The court will review and consider all comments received. If no substantive opposition to the proposed amendments is submitted by November 15, 2018, the court intends to enter a General Order adopting the proposed amended LBRs and LBFs, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 2071(e), Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9029, and United States District Court Miscellaneous General Order No. 880, without further notice.
